Why TSC Travel Soccer ?

TSC Travel Soccer focuses on three primary goals :

Player Development
Create an amazingly positive culture
Enjoyment of the Game

General Calendar for Travel Teams

- Tryouts in April/May (usually 3 sessions)
- Teams picked by early May
- Typically (but up to the coach) practices 1-2x per week June-Nov
- Games on Saturdays (very few Sundays at this age) mid-SEPT thru mid-NOV
- Most young teams take a break in NOV and DEC
- Some indoor training (again depends on families and coaches) JAN/FEB/MAR
- Indoor League (usually 8 weeks) JAN/FEB/MAR Depends on team interest
- Spring League April/May Depends on coach and team interest

Frequently Asked Questions(FAQs)

Joining travel soccer is an exciting time for parents and players, but sometimes the words "travel soccer" can be a little intimidating. To help explain what First year/younger travel generally entails, we put together this FAQ to help.

When does travel soccer occur? Younger teams will practice 1-2x a week in the Summer/Fall (June-Nov) and Spring (April-early June). Some teams choose to play in an indoor league in the Winter. Teams play in the ICSL Fall and Spring(optionally) League. Games are on Saturday mornings mostly, sometimes in the afternoon and usually consist of 7-8 games each season.

How far is the travel? Most teams we will play in the younger ages of travel are located within 30 minutes of Towamencin, often closer. You also play 50% of your games at home. U-9 soccer do play in one or two fairly local tournaments in either the summer or Columbus Weekend (OCT). Some AWAY games could be as much as 45 minutes from Towamencin.

Can my son/daughter play other sports or activities while being on a travel team? The Towamencin Soccer Club is a believer in kids being able to be kids. We encourage and accommodate those that play other sports as well as have extra curricular activities separate from soccer. This is a belief we hold at all ages. There still should be a certain level of commitment to your travel soccer team.
